LECTURER, YALE SCHOOL OF DRAMA - AUGUST 2024 - PRESENT

Instructor for "Drafting in Sound Design. Additional appointment to help develop curriculum and manage learning spaces. Mentored students through their sound system design and drafting, then worked with them during load-in to test their skills.

Teaching Fellow for the Computer Science class "Creative Embedded Systems" under instructor Scott Peterson. Helped students to develop creative ideas and explore artistic concepts through their understanding of computer science.

INDEPENDENT STUDY INSTRUCTOR - YALE SCHOOL OF DRAMA - "DECONSTRUCTING SOUND DESIGN" FALL 2023

Led an Independent Study called "Deconstructing Sound Design." A class with a flexible format where students bring in pieces of music or sound that inspires them. We then listen critically, break down the components, and replicate the original sound using sampling, recording, and synthesis.

GUEST LECTURER - YALE SCHOOL OF DRAMA - SOUND SEMINAR "HISTORY OF TURNTABLISM" - SPRING 2020 & 2022
Twice offered a lecture on the history of turntablism. From Thomas Edison to DJ Kool Herc - the parallel cultural and technical development through WW2 France, Kingston DJ Culture, on into the Bronx,

Chicago, and the future. Hands on demonstrations of classic scratching and mixing techniques, and the influence they have had on our sonic lexicon.

GUEST LECTURER - HAMILTON COLLEGE - FALL 2023 - PRESENT

Guest in Intro to Design and Production and Advanced Lighting Design. Interactive Lecture on "What Does a Sound Designer Do," providing context for the process of a theatrical sound designer, with an emphasis on practical career growth. Followed by an exercise in "monster" design - I record students making weird mouth noises in the classroom and then demonstrate editing them, mixing them with additional sound effects and music, then bring the magic together with Q Lab in the theater. Interactive Lecture on "Show Control Systems." Providing a broader context of theatrical show control including Scenic Automation, Lighting, Sound, Stage Management, and linking systems via OSC or MIDI. Demonstration of skills by linking Q Lab with an Eos Console and designing lights and sound in parallel.

GUEST LECTURER - YALE SCHOOL OF ART - MOVING IMAGE METHODS - FALL 2024 - SPRING 2025

Provided a basic introduction to recording and editing methods for film. At the request of the same instructor, provided a similar lecture for Yale College's intro to Digital Video class.

Worked with five 5th grade playwrights to create sound design and composition for 15 minute plays. One of the most engaging creative endeavors I have worked on - nothing stimulates the imagination like a 5th grader with prompts like "a moon made of cheese." Worked with students to help them find their own sonic identity in the piece, writing wraps and producing beats, designing effects, recording voice overs, etc. in a summer-camp style educational experience / production.
